RE: End of Term Arrangements

Dear Parent / Carer,

The last day of school for Year 11 will be Friday 23rd May. Following this date, subjects which have not yet finished exams: English, Maths, Science, History, Geography, French, Spanish and Textiles will continue teaching during normal lesson time. The timetable on page 2 of this letter makes it clear when students should be in school.

Does my child need to wear uniform?

Yes. Exams, lessons and revision sessions that are not at weekend will need to be attended in uniform.

What are the arrangements for Friday 23rd May?

There is an English exam in the morning. All students are expected to attend the morning briefing and sit the exam in full school uniform. The exam will start as normal at 9:00am. There will be an opportunity to change into celebration shirts after the exam.

Will the students be sent home earlier than normal?

Yes. At 10:45am there will be a special assembly for Year 11 and they will then be dismissed into the quiet playground. around 12:30pm all Year 11 will exit via the Farmer Road gate. They are then expected to make their way home.

Will there be revision sessions over half-term?

Yes, some subjects have not finished all their exams. We have enclosed a timetable, which your child will also receive.

Do students need to wear school uniform to exams?

Yes. After half-term if your child is on-site for any reason they are expected to be dressed in uniform. Anyone not in uniform for exams or revision sessions may be asked to go home and change.

After half-term are the teachers running any additional revision sessions?

Yes. They are indicated on the timetable. It is important that your child arrives on time as they may not be allowed on-site if they are late. We will also be sending reminder text messages to help parents support their child to attend.

Will there be revision sessions before all the exams?

Yes. All morning exams will have a pre-exam session at 8:15am and afternoon exam have a pre-exam session at the start of lesson 3 (11:20pm Mon-Thurs, 10:40pm Fri).
